Location

Located in the South China Sea on the west coast of the island of Borneo, Sabah is easily accessible by sea and air. The international airport, 5 minutes from Sutera Harbour Resort, has flights departing to countless major cities throughout the Asian region via links with Kuala Lumpur and Singapore, and an increasing amount of direct flights to the island.

Approach by Sea

Come in on a heading of 090°T, keeping Tanjung Wakong ½ mile to port. When at Tanjung Wakong, turn towards Sutera Harbour Resort, course 128°T. Note: This approach is using Admiralty Chart #3626. However, the most recent chart does not indicate Sutera Harbour Resort's location. Futhermore, the charted depth outside the Marina is no longer accurate, as the Marina channel has been dredged and expanded. The average depth at lowest astronomical tide (LAT) is 5 meters inside the basin and 7 meters just outside the breakwater.
